

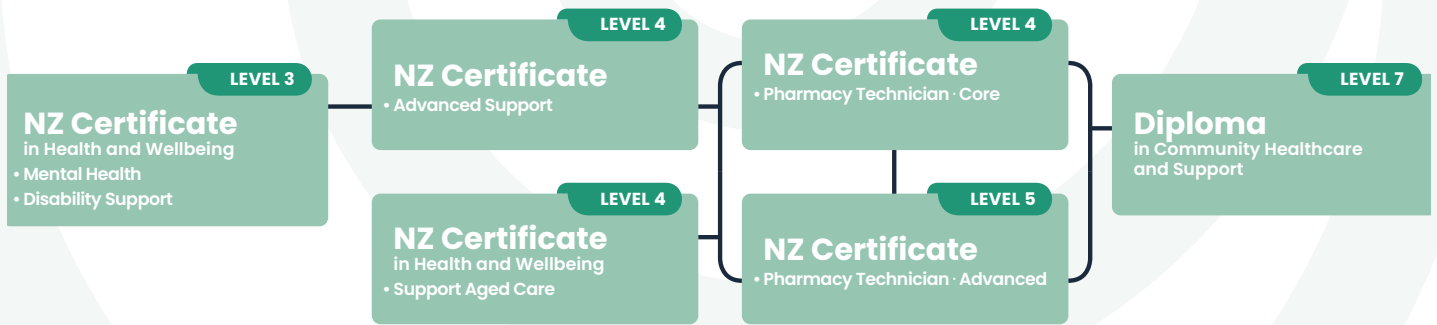

The aim of this Flexible-Learning programme is to equip people who have experience in the health or wellbeing sector with the skills, knowledge and attributes required for advanced person-centred support. Caring for those with complex needs, and to their family/whānau, you'll be prepared to take a leadership role in healthcare, particularly in aged care. The learning gained within this programme is transferred into work practice, with a supervised work placement in a New Zealand healthcare organisation.

Light up your future and pursue your passion in caring for people. This programme is designed to provide graduates with the specialist skills, knowledge and professional attributes required to provide person-centred support to those with mental health and/or addiction needs; or people with disabilities – as well as extending care to their family/whanau.

Throughout the programme, gain skills that are designed for work practice: Experience a supervised work placement in a New Zealand mental health and addiction service; or disability support service. Graduates will be prepared for entry level roles in a mental health facility; addiction or disability support organisation.
